Dear Parents and Carers,

Harvest Festival Friday 21st September

Over the next week our children will be thinking about Harvest with their teachers in preparation for our annual Harvest Festival celebrations at the church in Yarnton. This year our school, along with the church, will be supporting the North Oxfordshire Community Foodbank. The children are invited to bring tins or packets of food, which we will display in the church and then take to the food bank. Food which is currently needed by the food bank includes: tins of fruit, custard, pudding rice, pasta sauce, tins of meat, tins of vegetables, rice, pasta, breakfast cereal, packets of tea, coffee, tins of soup, jams, and baked beans. On the morning of our Harvest celebrations we will take the food to the church to display and then all of the food will be taken to the food bank by members of the church. If you are able to help with walking the children to the church, please talk to your child's class teacher.

Our year 6 have been on their residential visit to Glasbury in Wales this week. They have had a super time and we are all looking forward to hearing about their week when they return on Friday evening. It has certainly been very quiet in school without them!

Children in year 3 and 4 were treated to a musical session this week with some members of Yarnton brass band. Children in these classes have been given letters about Brass instrumental lessons at school, please do let me know if you are interested in your child learning to play a brass instrument.

The Yarnton Brass Band will be performing at school next week on the evening of Thursday 20th September at 7.00pm. This concert is free and will be a good opportunity for our children to listen to some excellent live music.
