<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>This term we will be using our imaginations to create our very own fairy tales. The children will be thinking about how to make their writing exciting for their readers and the impact they can have as an author. The children will then be investigating recounts and newspaper reports and will produce their own, focusing on a Viking raid. Term 3 will finish with the children reading and writing some performance poetry. During term 4, we will be looking at a wide range of texts and writing some myths and legends.</p>	<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>We will be studying all four number operations. We will be learning about measures, shapes and about interpreting data.</p> <p>We are aiming to improve the speed of our recall of times tables and having regular practice sessions and times tables tests to help our progress.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>As Scientists school we will be exploring what it means to have a healthy lifestyle. We will act as personal trainers for our clients, mentoring them in both diet and exercise. We will learn how muscles work and which food -types we need to eat and which to avoid.</p>
<p><b>Art and Design Technology</b></p> <p>We will study and recreate Islamic tiles with painted patterns.</p> <p>We will be studying Anglo-Saxon clothes and jewelry and making brooches from card and papier mache.
