## Road Works and Cassington Road

Please be aware that due to a collapsed sewer, road works are taking place outside the entrance to Paternoster Farm. A three way temporary traffic light system is in place incorporating Cassington Road/Church Lane/Rutten Lane. Having spoken to CAPPAH, the contractors, it is scheduled to last for up to 10 days. I suspect the net effect will be that some traffic from Cassington will try to avoid the lights by turning into Rutten Lane to access the A44, thereby causing more traffic to pass William Fletcher School. School staff and parents need to be made aware of this likely increase in traffic particularly during drop off and collection times.
