Dear Parents and Carers,

**Re: Possible reopening of school to more pupils in June**

You will have seen in the news that schools may reopen on 1 June to reception, year 1 and year 6 pupils **if** the government thinks it is safe to do so.

We are reviewing the further guidance the government sent out last night to all schools, which we hope will help us to create an action plan for a phased reopening. We will share this with you as soon as possible so you know what the school's reopening will look like in practice.

It is a very unsettling time for us all but rest assured, that we are going to be doing everything we can to make sure we are ready to receive these year groups, once we are advised it is safe to do so.

However, we are not going to be pressuring anyone to send their children to school, since you know your children and personal situation best. We will keep you updated with all our preparations for making sure the school is as safe as possible, in order that you can make an informed decision.

In the meantime, the school is still open for vulnerable pupils and the children of critical workers **only**.

We know some employers will be encouraging you to return to work, but we're not in a position right now to extend places to other children until we receive further government guidance.

We would like to thank you for your continued support in helping your child learn from home. We will need to keep going with this for a while yet, so please do continue to do what you can and stay in touch with us about how your child is doing.
