Evidence Me – online communication tool



Please do not allow your child to bring in toys from home. Toys can become a little distracting to children throughout the day and occasionally go missing which causes distress. Toys are best left at home to avoid any of this. Thank you.

Labelling belongings

Please label every item of clothing plus lunchboxes, drink bottles, sun hats and shoes. This helps us match items to the rightful owner should things go missing. In the warmer weather children remove their jumpers regularly. Jumpers and cardigans must be named.
