Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to the Prime Minister's announcement this evening and in line with the government's new regulations that all schools must now close and teaching must go online, myself, the senior leadership team and governors will be working together to ensure that an appropriate and full timetable is available to all of our children.

Given the short notice of tonight's announcement, we will not be in a position to roll out the Google Classroom learning to all pupils tomorrow (Tuesday). As such, in order that all pupils have access at the same time, we will start from **9am on Wednesday (January 6, 2021)**.

Children in Foundation Stage will receive their work from Mrs Haynes and Miss Coulson via Evidence Me and emails to parents.

For those parents and carers that are classified as critical / key workers, school will remain open to your children. Your children should arrive at 9am and must be collected at 3pm. (School will be open tomorrow (Tuesday) for children of critical / key workers and vulnerable children).

If however, you do not need to utilise this facility, it would help us if your child could access the online learning via Google Classrooms or the Foundation Stage option at home.

Unfortunately we will not be able to offer Breakfast Club during this time.
