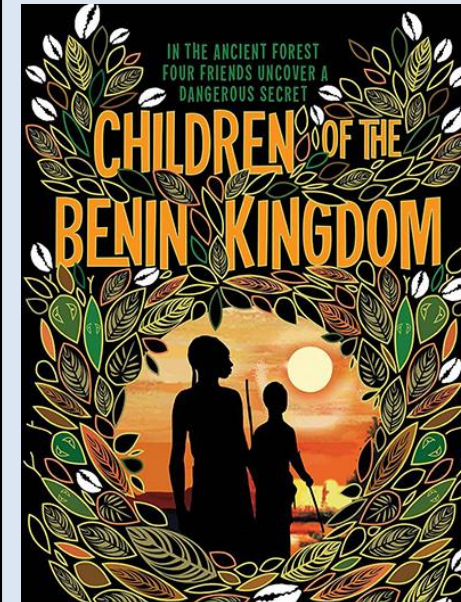
As Scientists we will be learning about how animals can adapt to survive in their environment and understand how living things have changed over time.
