Science

In Science the children will become experts in Light and Sound. We will discover how light allows us to see and explore shadows. During our topic on sound, we will learn how sounds are made, how the pitch and volume of a sound can be changed and lots of other interesting facts.

Design Technology

We will be practising basic technology skills involving measuring, cutting and joining, before moving on to larger construction activities.
