In History, we will be looking at the Benin Kingdom. We will understand where it was, how the people of Benin lived their lives and their culture.

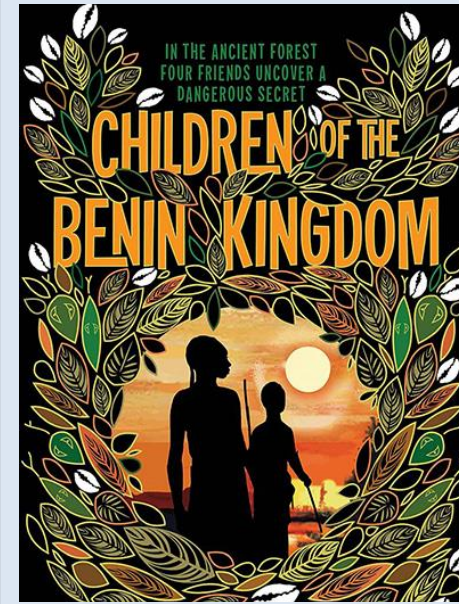
